

International Master's Program in Learning and Instruction Guidelines for the Implementation of Graduate Student Scholarship

Approved at the 1st Program Affairs Meeting of the 2nd Semester, Academic Year 2017 (2018/3/7)

Approved at the 1st Program Affairs Meeting of the 1st Semester, Academic Year 2018 (2018/10/8)

Article 1

These Guidelines are established in accordance with the “National Taipei University of Education Regulations for Graduate Student Scholarships.”

Article 2

The purpose of these Guidelines is to encourage graduate students of the International Master's Program in Learning and Instruction (hereinafter referred to as “the Program”) to actively participate in program affairs and demonstrate commitment to learning.

Article 3

The scholarship shall be open for application once per semester (March and October). The Program will notify first- and second-year master's students. Eligible students shall complete the application form. The final decision shall be made by the Program Affairs Meeting, and the scholarship will be granted following administrative procedures.

Article 4

Eligibility, evaluation criteria, and scholarship amount are as follows:

1. Eligibility (all of the following conditions must be met):

- (1) Full-time first- or second-year master's students enrolled in the Program.
- (2) Not receiving the Taiwan Scholarship.
- (3) Academic performance from the previous semester must be above 80 points.

2. Evaluation Criteria and Scholarship Amount:

Applicants who meet the eligibility requirements shall be reviewed by the Program Affairs Committee, which will determine the recipients and the amount of the scholarship.

Article 5

These Guidelines shall be implemented upon approval by the Program Affairs Meeting and subsequent ratification by the President. The same procedure shall apply to any amendments.

Article 6

In the event of any discrepancies between the Chinese and English versions, the Chinese version shall prevail.
